



ColourCore Cardstock

This acid and lignin-free cardstock contains a coordinating coloured core which allows for lots of interesting techniques.



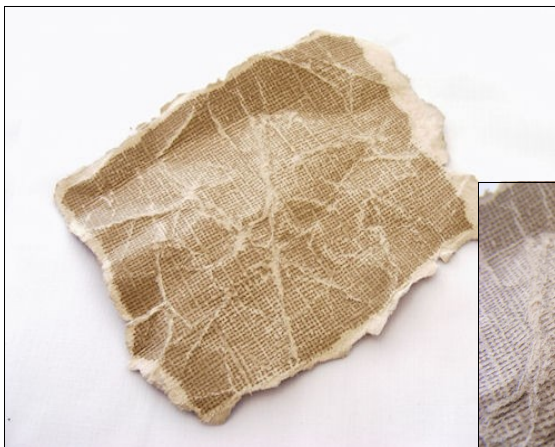
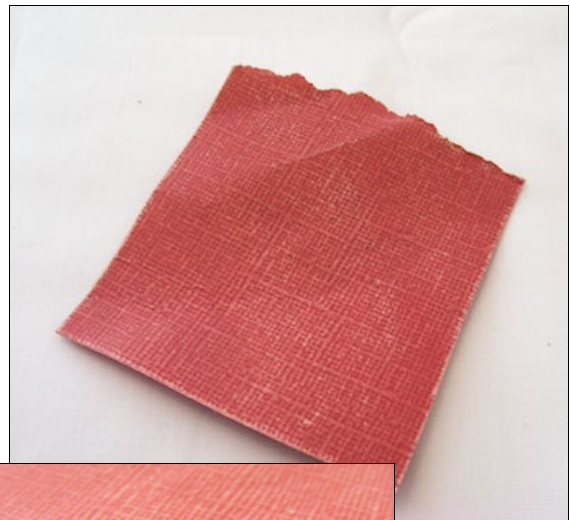
Tearing:

Tearing the cardstock allows the colour core to show. This can be particularly effective when matting and layering on your cards or scrapbooking pages.

Sanding:

The cardstock has a raised canvas effect so when you sand it, the colour core will show through the raised areas – enhancing the canvas effect of the card.

You can change the effect of sanding by using less or more coarse sandpaper.



Antiquing:

Crumpling the card and sanding can give your card a weathered antique look.



Embossing:

Sanding an embossed image on the colour core cardstock will bring the core colour to the surface and makes your embossing more prominent.



Coredinations CoreColour Cardstock is available in 48 colours – either as individual sheets or as coordinating colour packs.

Also available is the Black Magic cardstock range. This cardstock has a black surface and a coloured back. You can apply the above techniques to bring colour into your black cardstock or visa versa. The Black Magic range is available in packs.
