

Good Luck Pots



Materials from Arcade Crafts:
Blank A6 white card & envelope
Purple card
Flower Soft Wires
Flower Soft Floral Papers
Flower Soft Alpha-Pots
Flower Soft – Spring & Light Green
Flower Soft Glue
White Ribbon
Sticky Foam Pads
Scissors
Double Sided Tape
Decorative Edge Scissors

You will also need:
Piece of foam or a ball of plasticine
Piece of white cotton

1. Create your flower stems by cutting the 6 wires to roughly 3"/8cm in length. Cover the top 2/3 of a wire with glue and then sprinkle your Spring Flower Soft over the stems until they are covered. Place this in the foam or plasticine to dry. Repeat this with the rest of the wires.

3. Cut out the alpha-pots to spell 'good luck'. Using your finger, shape each pot so that it is slightly curved. Starting with the K in the bottom right, stick 2 foam pads -top and bottom- in the centre of your pot and stick in place as shown.

5. To put the bouquet together, gather all your Flower Soft stems. Trim the bottoms so that they are all the same length. Put some glue on the wires just below the Flower Soft. Wrap a piece of sewing cotton tightly around the stems. This will hold your stems together. Tie a bow around the wires using the white ribbon.

2. Using your decorative scissors, cut a rectangle 3 1/2" x 5" (9 x 12.5cm) from the floral paper. Cut a smaller rectangle about 2" x 4" (5 x 10cm) from the purple card. Stick both of these rectangles in the centre of the card as shown.

4. Put some glue at the top of each stack of alpha-pots, allowing it to overlap the top of the pots. Sprinkle the light green Flower Soft over the glue and shake off the excess.

6. Stick the bouquet at the top right of the card. To keep the ribbon in place, lay the ends where you would like them to fall and glue in place.

You could use different change the alpha-pots for different greeting and change the colour to suit other occasions.
