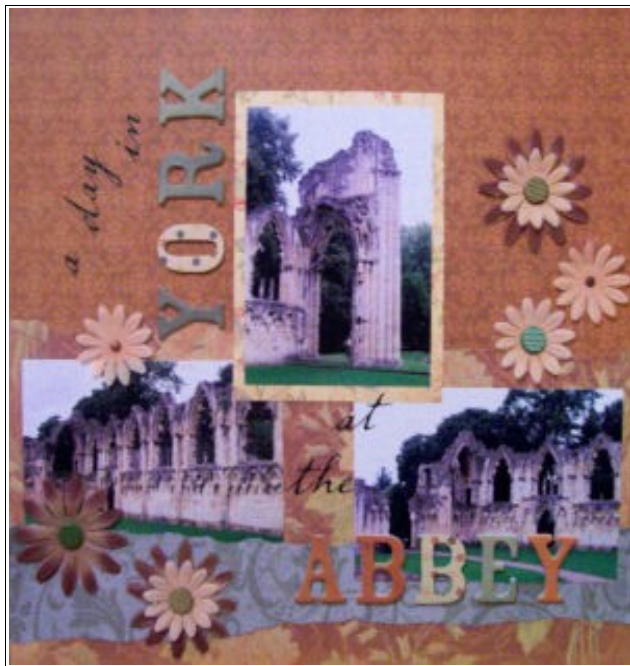


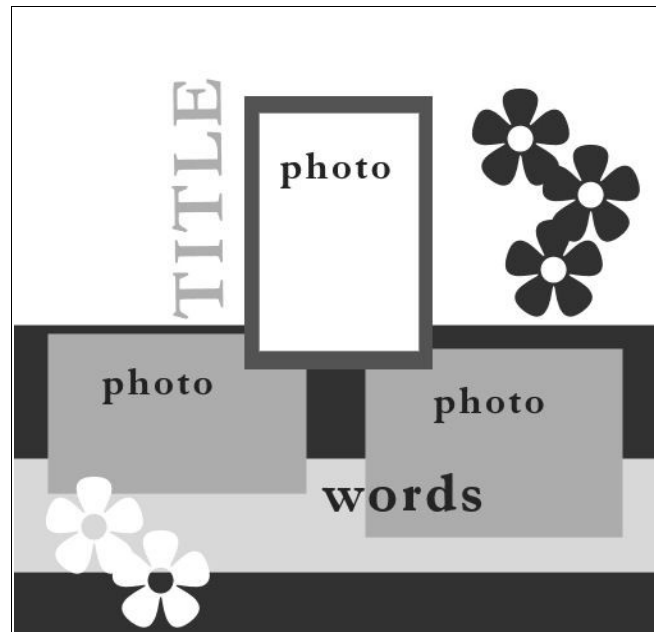
Sketch 1

This project will explain how you can create the scrapbooking layout below from this sketch and how you can create your own personal layout.

The layout below has taken direct inspiration from the sketch. To begin with, a 12" x 12" paper was torn in half and stuck across the bottom half of the background paper. The photograph on the left was stuck then stuck in place and a torn paper strip stuck across the width of the page towards the bottom.

The right photo was then stuck in place. The center photograph was mounted onto a rectangle of patterned paper and stuck in place. Fabric flowers were then attached to the page with brads. The words 'York' and 'Abbey' were added using chipboard letters and the rest of the wording was added using alphabet rub-ons.

You can use the sketch above using your own photographs, papers and an appropriate title. You can also move the elements of the sketch around - try using a different number of photographs or move them round.

You could also use other suitable embellishments instead of the flowers.
